Courses taught in Italian must be included in the learning agreement in Italian language
No learning agreements with exam names translated into English will be accepted.

Bachelor degree courses are only delivered in Italian, in addition:

The single-cycle degree courses (five-year architecture) are delivered in Italian.

IN ADDITION...

- All the exams consisting of several modules must be fully taken --> it is MANDATORY to take all the modules that make up an exam.

- No specific credits are provided for those who have selected 'thesis research' as the motivation for their mobility; the Italian tutor will eventually assign credits on the basis of the work carried out.

Some of the courses delivered in English will have a limited number of participants, and, in case you don't find a place, you will have the opportunity to take the equivalent course in Italian, supported by teachers who will provide the material in English.

Important: as per the resolution of the Sapienza Academic Senate, teaching activities (exams, lessons, internships, etc.) cannot be provided online, but only in person, so please make sure to organize your study plan in line with the teaching calendar of your university of origin.

You have - from the day you receive the email with logins from erasmusincoming@uniroma1.it - 45 days to upload documents: no learning and documents sent after that date will be accepted (so your application will be rejected).

Exams/ Lessons calendar (being updated):

First semester lessons: from the last week of September to the second week of January

Exams Winter session: from the last week of January to the last week of February

Second semester lessons: from the first week of March to the last week of May

Exams Summer session: from the first week of June to the last week of July
